



## **NIMCET-2021**

(NIT MCA COMMON ENTRANCE TEST)

### **Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)**

#### **(A) Online Application Related**

**1. What are the eligibility criteria to appear for NIMCET-2021?**

The eligibility criteria to appear for NIMCET-2021 test are given in Section 2 of the Information Brochure of NIMCET-2021 available on the website <https://www.nimcet.in>.

**2. How do I apply ONLINE?**

For online application, you need to logon on to the website <https://www.nimcet.in>. The online application process is explained in Section 6 of the Information Brochure of NIMCET 2021.

**3. What should I do, if the power/internet connection failed during the submission of the application process?**

Please login to the NIMCET website again and continue the online application process.

**4. What is the fee structure for NIMCET-2021 examination?**

The non-refundable application processing fee for NIMCET-2021 examination is Rs. 2500/- for OPEN/OPEN-EWS/OBC category and Rs. 1250/- for SC/ST/PwD category candidates. The fee structure for NIMCET-2021 is given in the Section 5 of the Information Brochure.

**5. How do I make fee payment for the NIMCET examination?**

The fee for NIMCET-2021 examination is to be paid **ONLINE** only. Please refer to Section 6, point No. 8 of the Information Brochure of NIMCET-2021 for fee payment procedure.

**6. My net banking account has been debited more than once. How do I get the money back?**

Any unaccounted or excess money received on behalf of NIMCET-2021 from any bank account, will automatically be returned (credited) to the same bank account. However, this may take a week or more time, after the closure of the application process.

**7. Do I have to send the print-out of the application form?**

No, the print-out of the application form is not required to be sent to the Organizing Institute NIT Raipur or any other participating NITs.

**8. When and how will I know the status of my application?**

You can check the status of your application by logging into the official website of the NIMCET-2021: <https://www.nimcet.in>.

**9. What to do if I forgot the password?**

You can click on 'Forgot Password' and then you have to enter your registered email-id and answer the security question. An email will be sent to your registered e-mail id with instructions on how to reset password.

**10. Can I change my email-id after registration for future notifications?**

**No.** Once you register your email id, it will be the primary email-id and all the NIMCET-2021 related communication will be sent to this e-mail id only. To receive notifications on another or new email id, you have to register again with that new e-mail id.

**11. Where are the test centers for NIMCET-2021 located?**

The test centers for NIMCET-2021 would be tentatively in **27 various** cities across the country. The tentative list of cities where test centers of the NIMCET-2021 examinations would be located is given in Section 9 of the information brochure.

**12. Can I change the allotted test center for NIMCET-2021 test?**

**No.** The allotted test centre for NIMCET-2021 test **will not** be changed under any circumstances.

**13. Can I edit the online application form after the final submission?**

No, you cannot edit the online application form after the final submission.

**14. Whether Aadhaar card is essential for filling the form?**

No, any Government documents (Voter ID card, PAN card, Indian Passport, Driving License issued in India) can be used for identification purposes based on the options available on the website.

**15. What are the criteria and required documents to claim OP-EWS?**

At the time of online application form filling EWS certificate of the current year (i.e. issued on or after April 1, 2020) which is issued by a competent authority is required to be uploaded (duly self-attested scanned copy). Candidates applying in this category must-read clause number 6.1(5) of the Information Brochure of NIMCET-2021.

**16. Do I have to upload SC/ST/OBC/OP-EWS/PWD certificates?**

Yes, if you belong to a particular category and want to claim the entitled benefit of that category then you have to upload the corresponding certificate. Sample certificates are given in the information brochure of NIMCET-2021 available on the website.

**17. Which OBC list is to be referred to - Central or State?**

The Central list of OBC will be referred to, please refer the National Commission for Backward Classes (NCBC) website [www.ncbc.nic.in](http://www.ncbc.nic.in).

**18. Is it necessary to use the same format as given in the NIMCET-2021 information brochure for SC/ST certificate?**

Not necessarily. However, the content of the certificate must be the same. Hindi/English version is preferred. If the certificate is in any other regional language, an authorized and duly attested translation of the same in Hindi/English should be provided along with the certificate.

**19. What should be the size of document that is to be uploaded?**

- The Size of photograph and signature of the candidate must be in between 50KB to 1MB.
- Format of the Photograph and signature can be JPEG, JPG only.
- The quality of the Photograph and signature should be good.
- Size of all other documents must be between 50KB to 1MB and it must in **.pdf format** only.

**20. I am not able to upload eligibility certificate/document even though the certificate is valid as well as of size between 50KB and 1MB. Can you please help?**

Please clear the **cache** of your browser and then try again.

**21. How to upload Grade?**

Please check the grading system followed in your University/Institute. Normally, the description of maximum grade, letter grades and equivalent grade point is given on the backside of grade sheet/card. Subject credit is the credit of individual subject which is normally mentioned against the name of each subject in the grade sheet/card. When you have selected scale of marks as CGPA you need to enter the maximum Grade (or the CGPA scale) which is used in your university / institute.

**Example :**

CGPA scale (Max Grade) is 10 and letter grades are, say, A+, A, B+, B, C+, C, where, A+ is the highest letter grade and C is the lowest one. The equivalent grade point will normally be as follows (however, please check with your grade sheet/card):-

<b>Letter Grade</b>	<b>Grade Points (Max Grade=10)</b>
A+	10
A	9
B+	8
B	7
C+	6
C	5

If the CGPA scale (Max CGPA) in your University is 7, then letter grade A+ in the above example will have equivalent grade point 7 and so on.

**22. How to upload the marksheet?**

If your qualifying degree is in annual system, then you need to upload the self-attested photocopy of marksheet/card of first, second and third year. If your university/institute follows semester system then you need to club self-attested marksheet/Grade card of first two semesters in one **pdf**

document and upload it. This acts as marksheet/Grade sheet of 1<sup>st</sup> year and same process should be carried out for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year.

**23. Can I Upload documents without attestation?**

No, you must upload duly Self Attested Documents.

**24. What to do if I don't receive conformation mail?**

Please Refer to Point Number 6 (3) of the NIMCET 2021 Information Brochure.

**25. My name's spelling is different as mentioned in Aadhaar. What to do?**

You should enter name should be as per the 10th Class certificate.

**26. Is a caste certificate necessary to fill the form?**

YES, if you are claiming any reservation.

**27. I am not able to access my mail account. How do I get information and updates??**

Email pertaining to any updates in information will not be sent to candidates. Candidates are advised to frequently visit the NIMCET 2021 website for updated information.

## **(B) Related to Examination and Admission**

**1. What is the test pattern for NIMCET-2021 test?**

NIMCET-2021 test will be a **online** test conducted with only one question paper containing 120 multiple-choice questions (MCQs) from different subjects i.e. Mathematics, Analytical Ability & Logical Reasoning, Computer Awareness, and General English. For a detailed test pattern, please refer Section 12 of the NIMCET-2021 Information Brochure.

**2. What is the syllabus for NIMCET-2021 test?**

The detailed syllabus for NIMCET-2021 test is given in Section 12.2 of the NIMCET-2021 Information Brochure available on the official website.

**3. What are the criteria for allotment of rank in NIMCET-2021?**

A candidate scoring zero or negative marks either in Mathematics or in Total Marks in NIMCET-2021 test will be disqualified. Based on the marks obtained by a qualified candidate in NIMCET-2021 test, a rank will be allotted by adopting the criteria specified in the Section 13 of the Information Brochure of NIMCET-2021.

**4. Whether the organizing Institute will send the admit card to candidate individually by post?**

The admit card **will not** be sent to the candidate individually by post. Candidate must download his/her admit card from the website <https://www.nimcet.in> during the specified period.

**5. What are the documents I need to carry while going to appear in the examination?**

- Printed copy of Admit card.
- Original copy of Identity Document (ID proof) that was specified while filling the application online.

**6. Can I bring soft copy of the Admit Card (in mobile phone/tablet/laptop) to gain entry to the examination centre?**

No. Hard copy of the Admit Card must be brought to the examination centre along with at least one **original** (not photocopied/scanned copy) and valid (not expired) Identity Document (ID), which was specified during the filling up of the online application.

**7. What is the admission procedure in various participating NITs if I get a good all India rank in NIMCET-2021 test?**

The admission in the participating NITs will be offered to the candidates only on the basis of all India rank secured by him/her in the NIMCET-2021 test. The detailed procedure for admission in participating NITs is given in the Section 14 of Information Brochure.

**8. I am from Hindi medium do I am eligible for NIMCET?**

YES, you are eligible for NIMCET provided you must possess eligibility criteria mention in Section 2 of Information brochure of NIMCET 2021.

**9. I have completed my graduation through distance learning. Am I eligible for NIMCET?**

Please refer eligibility criteria mention in Section 2 of Information brochure of NIMCET 2021.

**10. Whether the NIMCET-2021 will be held in different medium?**

No, NIMCET-2021 test will be conducted only in English Language only and will not be translated into any other language.

**11. What will be the pattern of NIMCET -2021 Examinations?**

Please refer test pattern mention in Section 12 of the Information brochure of NIMCET 2021.

**12. Can I give/appear online NIMCET 2021 Entrance examination from the place of my convenience?**

NO, You have to give/appear in the online NIMCET 2021 entrance examination from the allotted test center only.
